

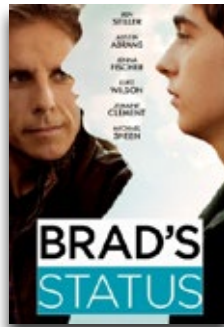


Movie Night Guidelines

- **Solivita residents must present their ID badge for admission. Adult guests (age 18 and over only) are welcome by presenting their guest pass.**

Lifestyles Events Ticket Sale Information

- The main ticket sale will be **THURSDAY, MARCH 1ST** in the **BALLROOM** from 9am-10am for **March and April tickets**. **Doors open at 8am**. Afterwards, tickets will be sold at the Lifestyles office Monday-Friday from 9am-5pm. Clubs selling tickets are also to remain until 10am.
- All residents will need to present their resident ID badges.
- Maximum of 4 tickets can be purchased per resident, per event, unless otherwise stated.
- You can pay by check made payable to *Avatar Properties Inc. Solivita Club*, credit/debit card, or cash (**EXACT CASH AMOUNT ONLY**).
- The first month a Lifestyles event goes on sale, tickets are for residents only (unless otherwise specified). After this, if the event is not sold out, adult guests are welcome and residents can purchase any remaining ticket(s).
- Ticket(s) can be returned for **CREDIT ONLY**; no credit will be given less than 5 days prior to the event.
- Credit will not be issued for lost or stolen ticket(s).

Solivita Car Show **Saturday, March 10th**

Hosted by the Car Show Committee and Lifestyles Activities

Spend the day checking out 125 plus show stopping classic, muscle and hot rod cars displayed along the entire Village Center! In addition there will be cash-only food concession stands, music entertainment by *DJ JR Goodman*, raffles outside the Art Gallery, Car Show shirts for sale at the Meals on Wheels/Car Show Info Booths and the strolling Rockabilly girls. A motorcycle display presented by the Solivita Older Bikers (SOBs) will be outside the Ballroom, a RV display by the Solivita RV Club will be in the Ballroom parking lot and new this year, a custom golf cart display by Solivita residents (with advance pre-registration with Lifestyles) will be near the RVs.

This event is complimentary, open to the public and guests of all ages are welcome. Event is from 10am-3pm, winner announcements are at 1:30pm on the Village Center bridge, and the parade of cars follows. SMOKING IS PROHIBITED IN EVENT AREAS. THE WATERFRONT GALLERIES AND VILLAGE DRIVE FROM THE BALLROOM TO THE PRO SHOP WILL BE CLOSED TO TRAFFIC, EXCEPT TO PARTICIPANTS IN THE SHOW, FROM 6:30AM-3PM.

Registration Information: Participant deadline is March 2nd (goody bag is not guaranteed). Over \$1,800 worth of prizes will be awarded for numerous categories. Proceeds go to the local Meals on Wheels charity.

St. Patrick's Day Parade & Street Party **Saturday, March 17th**

Today we're all Irish! Aren't you lucky? Wear all green, or be pinched (or sprayed with green silly string)! On this day, we celebrate with a parade where you dress up your golf cart, club members, bicycle or yourself in all green, gold and rainbow. *Cars are not permitted.* We will have prizes for: Most Green, Luckiest, O'Funniest and Best "Irish" Group. **Parade participants are to meet in the Welcome Center Courtyard at 5pm for judging and the parade will start at 6pm.** The parade will begin with a bag piper and will end with a leprechaun stilt walker. After the parade, let the shenanigans begin with a street party. Food and dessert will be available from assorted food trucks. Green beer and drinks can be purchased at several cash-only bars, *DJ Penny* will get you dancing like a *leprechaun* on the street by the Ceramics Gallery and the *Irish Echoes* will be *Irish Step Dancing* inside the Ballroom. **Free entry. Guests of all ages are welcome, but NO dogs are permitted. Smoking is prohibited in event areas. RAIN OR SHINE. VEHICLE TRAFFIC ON VILLAGE DRIVE FROM THE BALLROOM TO THE PRO SHOP WILL CLOSE AT 3PM, EXCEPT TO VENDORS, FOR SET UP.**

Rocketman: Elton John Tribute Show **Friday, March 23rd**

This show is an exact re-enactment of an early Elton John concert. Rus Anderson has spent years perfecting the piano playing, vocals, and mannerisms of Elton John and has traveled the world with thousands of performances to his credit. This insanely energetic tribute is endorsed by the official Elton John Fan Club! **There will be two shows: 5pm and 7:30pm. Ballroom doors open 20 minutes before the show begins. \$17 per person. Adult guests are welcome.**

Dinner & Rocketman: Elton John Tribute Show **Friday, March 23rd**

This event is an all-in-one dinner, show and QuickPass 10 minute early entrance show seating. Different food trucks participate every month, so take your pick from the various food and dessert trucks available. Food trucks do not sell any drinks; however, there will be a cash-only bar for beer, wine, soda and bottled water. *DJ Mike* will bring the music and seating is provided. Attendees are not permitted to bring alcohol and dogs are not permitted in the seating area. *This event may be rescheduled due to weather conflicts. Notification of date change will be sent through the community email blast.* **Free admission. Food trucks open for service from 4pm-7:30pm in front of the Veterans Memorial. Guests of all ages welcome.**

Spring Parade & Carnival **Saturday, March 31st**

This is a special day for all the grandkids! Hop on over to the fun, games, prizes and Easter eggs!
