

Fleetwood Mac shuffled personnel and experimented with styles, all the while releasing solid albums with chart topping hits such as *Landslide*, *Rhiannon*, *Go Your Own Way*, *Don't Stop*, *Dreams*, *Say You Love Me*, and *Hold Me*, among others.
