## Movie Night Guidelines

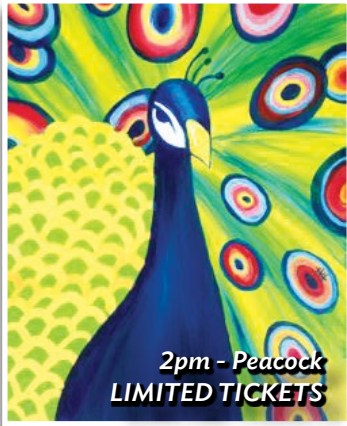
- Movie may be changed at any time due to availability.
